**Hon'ble Supreme Court** held that the length of the sentence or the gravity of the original crime can't be the sole basis for refusing premature release says while directing release of two convicts on probation. **Satish @ Sabbe V. The State of Uttar Pradesh, Special Leave Petition (Crl) No. 7369 of 2019.**

**Hon'ble Supreme Court** held that transfer of criminal cases cannot be ordered under Sec.406 of the Code of Criminal Procedure on the ground of lack of territorial jurisdiction even before evidence is marshalled. **Kaushik Chatterjee V. State of Haryana, 2020 SCC Online SC 793.**

**Hon'ble Supreme Court** held that there cannot be any inherent right to compassionate appointment. The Compassionate appointment has to be in terms of the applicable policy as existing on the date of demise, unless a subsequent policy is made applicable retrospectively. **State of Madhya Pradesh V. Smit Shrivastava, Civil Appeal No.8564 of 2015.**

**Hon'ble Supreme Court** held that the circumstances not put to an accused under Sec.313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure cannot be used against him and must be excluded from consideration. **Maheshwar Tigga V. The State of Jharkhand, 2020 SCC Online SC 779.**

**Hon'ble Supreme Court** held that the absence of motive in a case depending on circumstantial evidence is a factor that weigh's in favor of the accused. **Anwar Ali V. State of Himachal Pradesh, 2020 SCC Online SC 776.**

**Delhi High Court** says that it doesn't have advisory jurisdiction to provide legal advice to the parties in application moved under 151 of the Civil Procedure Code. **Balraj Kishan Gupta V. Pannalal Giradhar Lal P.Ltd & Ors., Crl Appl.23164/2020.**

.....

**Delhi High Court** granted bail to a person accused under Sec.20 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs a Psychotropic substances act by noting that the prosecution failed to show any medical evidence to support it narrative that the accused is a drug addict. **Jay Hareh Somaiya V. Narcotic Control Bureau, Bail Appl.602/2020.**

**Delhi High Court** directed an insurance company that has suddenly discontinued an insurance plan, to provide a similar alternative plan to the claimant, having approximately the same coverage and the same premium. **Lokesh Chandra and Anr. V. National Insurance Company Ltd & Anr., W.P. 6674/2020.**

**Allahabad High Court** quashed an order of the chief Judicial Magistrate, dismissing the complainant registered against a Sub-Inspector, after the failed to appeal before the court. **Rajbahadur Singh V. State of U.P and Others, 2020 SCC Online All 1042.**

**Delhi High Court** has directed the Registry/Court Master not to the links for video conferencing with correspondents or any other person who is not connected with the case concerned. **Satyam Kumar Sah V. Narcotics Control Bureau, 2019 SCC Online Del 8409.**
